Step 1: Login with your Estrella username and password to begin the Grant Process.

Step 2: (New Requirement) Faculty or Staff who wish to submit a proposal must conduct a Face-to-Face Discussion with their Division Chair/Director before completing the proposal form. (NOTE: To begin the Face-to-Face Discussion form, Division Chair/Director(s) must login.)

Step 3: Faculty complete and submit their proposal.

Descriptions and Policies

Hybrid and Online Course Development

Hybrid/Online Course Development Process

Step1: Faculty member has a Face-to-Face discussion with their Division Chair about their intent to submit a Course Development proposal.

Step 2: The Course Development proposal form is submitted within the appropriate time frame.

Step 3: Faculty attend Hybrid and Online Redesign Workshops. Register for workshops.

Step 4: Over the course of a semester, in collaboration with the E-Learning Faculty Coordinator, the faculty member develops the course.

Step 5: Faculty presents the Hybrid/Online course to colleagues. Course is peer reviewed and the LOAF is completed.

Step 6: At the end of the semester, upon successful completion of the Hybrid/Online course, the faculty member receives the appropriate Stipend (unless he or she chose Re-assigned time as their compensation).

Step 7: Pilot semester: meet regularly with E-Learning Coordinator during Pilot semester.

Step 8: Complete <u>Learning Outcome Assessment form</u> & <u>SAAC EZ</u>.
